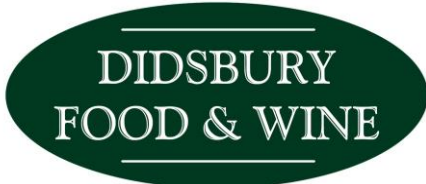

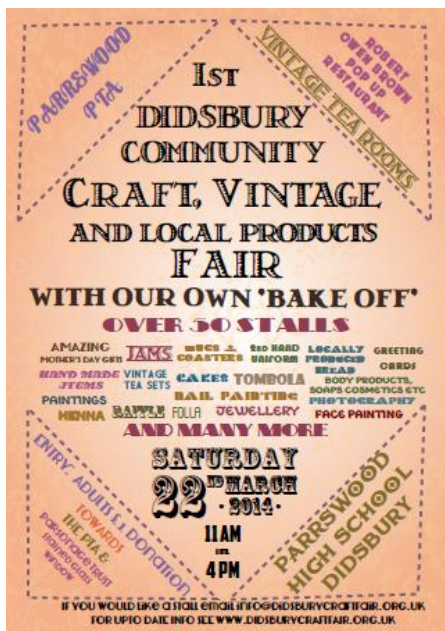
Shop signs

We will not now need to finalise the list of inscriptions for the plaque until after the end of March so the cut-off date for this scheme has been put back to March 31st.

Update on the Restoration work

As you can all see the work is now well underway. Our contractors are confident that all will be complete by the end of March.

The first task they undertook back in January was the removal of the old roof. From what I heard the workmen reckoned another major storm or snowfall would have seen the roof take itself down – it really was being held up by a few rusty inches of overlapping metal. Any serious inspection by the authorities over the past few years might have led to the whole edifice being removed for the safety of the public.

Most of the work in the last week or so has been carried out at the contractor's premises cleaning up the spandrels and casting replacement columns for those missing or badly damaged.

Shortly work will resume on site as the metalwork is put to rights and the roof installed. We are still expecting work to complete by the end of March.
